Course #1 Saturday, September 25, 2010 — 10am–12pm

"Misadventures in Dentistry Well Attached"

Presented by: Dr. Gerald S. Gildenberg, General Practice, Wall Twp.

This course answers the question: "What do you do so the clasps don't show?" Removable partial denture prosthetics is difficult enough, adding modern cosmetic considerations makes it a real challenge. Drawing on more than forty years tinkering with teeth Dr. Gildenberg will attempt to give some very practical incites in when, why and how to achieve good results when using precision attachments. All of us have our own 'tricks of the trade', we use to make life easier. This course will show you some of Dr. Gildenberg's best solutions. Although the cases shown will be on natural teeth, the information will also translate well for implant and clasped partials.

"Current Trends in Periodontal Care"
